

NOTE FOR THE SHORTLISTED CANDIDATES PhD Interview:

The PhD presentation & interview will be **offline (in-person)** for the Autumn Semester admission 2026-27. Any requests for online interviews will not be entertained unless for an exceptional situation. There will not be any written test.

Presentation and Interview:

For the presentation and interview, the candidate will be given a 30 minutes slot. The candidate must give a presentation of about 10 minutes, briefly touching upon their professional experience followed by the research interest, current status, lacunae and possible contribution. This will be followed by a 20 minutes interview and discussion.

The presentation should include:

- Background of the candidate in brief
- Research Proposal that contains:
- Present status (national, international)
- Justification of your selection of the topic
- Deliverable(s)

Selection:

Please note that the call for an interview does not guarantee an admission into the programme. The selection will be based on the performance in the interview and presentation. In addition to the proposal, knowledge on the subject, research/design aptitude and communication skills will also be tested during the interview. Decision of the admission committee will be final and cannot be changed under any circumstances.
